Create Ardmore's annual Scarecrow Contest is back! A family friendly contest that allows scarecrows to take over downtown Ardmore during the fall season. Categories include business, community organizations, individuals/families and kids. Scarecrows must be installed between 9 a.m. Saturday, October 10th and 5 p.m. Sunday, October 11th and removed between 9 a.m. Saturday, November 7th and 5 p.m. Sunday, November 8th.

"Scarecrow Experts" from Ardmore Beautification Council, Ardmore Chamber of Commerce, Ardmore City Commissioners and Ardmore Parks and Rec judge all entries, naming a 1st and 2nd place winner in each of the four categories. Create Ardmore will select one scarecrow for the creativity award. All judging decisions are final. Winners will be announced Tuesday, October 13th during the Scarecrow Stroll.



1ST Place = \$350 CASH
2nd Place = \$150 CASH
AWARDED IN EACH CATEGORY
Plus \$250 CASH Creativity Award

GUIDELINES: Each entry is allowed to install one scarecrow, and it must be a scarecrow. The scarecrow contest exhibit is expressly intended to be family friendly and may not contain religious, political or socially controversial characters, references or themes. Scarecrow should be whimsical, humorous, mischievous or lovable symbols of the season of Autumn, NOT frightening, monstrous, gruesome, or bloody Halloween decorations. Create Ardmore reserves the right to remove any display it considers not in keeping with the intent of this contest including but not limited to **anything that is not a scarecrow** or any display that takes up more than half of a bench. If assigned a bench, please only use the smallest amount of space for your scarecrow. Create Ardmore reserves the right to move a scarecrow to a different category.

SET UP AND TEAR DOWN: All entries must be installed between 9 a.m. Saturday, October 10th and 5 p.m. Sunday, October 11th and removed between 9 a.m. Saturday, November 7th and 5 p.m. Sunday, November 8th. Any remaining scarecrows will be removed and thrown away on Monday, November 9th.

Once your entry form is submitted, each scarecrow will be assigned a lamppost, pole or bench in the Ardmore downtown area and **must be securely attached to its lamppost, pole or bench with wire, rope or zip ties**. All scarecrows must be durable and able to withstand sun, wind and rain for the six-week display period. All ornamentation or props must be securely attached to the scarecrow. The use of real pumpkins or other natural materials is strictly prohibited, as they will deteriorate during the display period. No electronics may be used. You or a member of your group must inspect your scarecrow weekly to ensure it remains in an attractive display condition.

Each display should include the name of your scarecrow on a weatherproof sign no larger than 11x17 inches.

CATEGORIES:

BUSINESS – If your business is on Main Street, your scarecrow will be located as close to your business as possible.

COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION – For non-profits, public institutions or businesses that provide public services to the community.

INDIVIDUAL/FAMILY – For individuals and families.

KIDS – This category is specifically for groups of children, with a little adult supervision for safety's sake, but the scarecrow is designed and constructed mainly by kids.

No matter the category, your scarecrow can be a traditional 'crow with burlap, overalls and straw hat or a whimsical, fantastical 'crow based on a favorite character or one from your own imagination with bright colors and unique materials or you might want your 'crow to depict your amazing business, products or services you provide for Ardmore. **It's all up to you!**



Entries must be received by Wednesday, September 30th. Enter early as a limited number of display areas are available.
